Disc Golf at Daubendiek Park

Jefferson, Iowa

Construction of an 18-hole Disc Golf course will begin in 2021 at Daubendiek Park in Jefferson, Iowa!

Disc Golf is a game that plays and is scored like traditional golf, but rather than hitting balls with a club into holes, players throw flying discs (like Frisbees) from a designated tee to a metal, chained basket known as the "hole". Disc golf is a relatively young sport that is adding hundreds of new courses every year. Iowa is first in the nation for courses-per-capita, with 6.4-disc golf courses per 100,000 residents! One of the fastest growing aspects of disc golf is competitive tournament play. The desire to improve one's skills and compete for cash and prizes has increased demand for disc golf tournaments. An eighteen-hole competitive course at Daubendiek Park would bring players from the surrounding area into Jefferson to compete or improve their skills.

Disc golf is a sport everyone can play, regardless of age, ability, or gender. It can be played at least 3 seasons in our area. It provides the health benefits of outside exercise and is inexpensive to play. You can start playing with a single disc for less than \$10. It could become a source of revenue for Greene County Community Center/Jefferson Parks and Recreation.

When deciding to build a disc golf course at Daubendiek Park, there was one universally agreed upon request; that we make the best disc golf course possible. While disc golf courses require a fraction of the cost of many other sports venues and are much less environmentally destructive, it will still require support to create a true destination disc golf course, and this is where we need your help. To make this happen, we are asking for help in the form of monetary, material, and volunteer help. We want to reward those who are gracious enough to sponsor a portion of the course, but we understand that not everyone is able to donate in large amounts. Therefore, we have decided to create a list of donation threshold incentives for those who are willing to help us make the course a reality. We have decided on three levels of incentive but want to be as flexible to any donating capabilities as possible. The incentives are as follows:

1. Full Hole Sponsorship (\$1000) – The highest level of sponsorship, your donation will go to purchasing all necessary elements to complete one hole of the course, including the basket, tee areas, and signage materials. In reward, you will receive a large, permanent placard on the tee sign with your business logo, or a short, appropriate quote of your choosing or a personal statement, such as a dedication to or in memory of. These are limited to the number of holes on the course (18).
2. Half Sponsorship (\$500) – This donation will pay for approximately half of a hole. The placard for a tee can be shared with another half sponsorship with a business logo or dedication.

3. Large Monetary Donation (\$100-\$499) – This monetary level will be used to complete unsold holes or add beautifying elements of the disc golf course (landscaping, benches, signage, etc.). Your business/personal name will be placed in a list of all other sponsors of this level on a permanent course pavilion board.
4. Small Monetary Donation (\$1-\$99) – This donation will be used to complete any uncompleted holes or for beautifying elements of the disc golf course.
