Jefferson Matters: Main Street, Tower View Team, Home State Bank and Greene County Board of Supervisors invite you to their eighth annual exhibit of original outdoor sculptures.



Each artist, if selected, will receive a stipend of \$1,000.

Ring Out For Art is open to professional, student, and amateur sculptors of all backgrounds.

RING OUT FOR ART 2023 APPLICATION

CALL FOR ENTRIES

Four sculptures will be selected.

Each artist, if selected, will receive a stipend of \$1,000 with a chance to win an additional \$500.

Each selected sculptor will be paid \$700 on delivery and \$300 on pickup of their sculpture. Sculpture is owned by the artist and loaned to the exhibit from May 1, 2023 through November 1, 2023.

During this time, we will hold a public vote for the People's Choice Award. The result of this vote will determine which ONE of these four sculptures will remain in Jefferson until April 30, 2024 and will receive the extra \$500.

Please note: If the sculpture is removed before the specified removal period, the artist will forfeit the \$300. If a sculpture is damaged while on display, it is the artist's responsibility to repair the damaged sculpture or risk losing the final \$300.

You may submit up to 5 entries for jury. There is no entry fee.

All sculptures need to be made of a durable material for the outdoor setting and constructed with safety in mind for display in a public setting. Incorporating recycled/up-cycled materials is encouraged but not mandatory.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

This is a juried contest. The *Ring Out For Art* Selection Committee is comprised of members of Tower View Team, visual artists, and a member of the Greene County Board of Supervisors. Entries will be critiqued on artistic merit, creativity, public safety and durability in an **outdoor** environment.

SCULPTURE PLACEMENT

Sculptures must fit within a 4' x 4' square. No height requirement. Artist must configure a base that can be secured to the provided pad either with bolts or spot welded into place. If you are attaching with bolts you need a steel AND concrete bit to secure your sculpture. These bits will not be provided to the artist. We will have an experienced welder on site the day of your delivery to help with installation if needed.
