Gilded Mountain by Kate Manning – A brave young woman exposes the corruption that enriched her father's employers in early 1900s Colorado. Hang the Moon by Jeannette Walls – Sallie is the daughter of the richest man in a small Virginia town during Prohibition. She's a feisty and fearless, terrified and damaged young woman. The House at the End of the World by Dean Koontz - After a devastating loss and crushing injustice, Katie lives alone in an isolated stone house on Jacob's Ladder island. It soon becomes clear that the nearby island is home to dangerous secrets. **Love, Clancy** by W. Bruce Cameron – Clancy the dog is a recent addition to JayB's household, and Clancy loves him. Unfortunately for Clancy, the family also includes the cat, Kelsey.

Loyalty by Lisa Scottoline - Franco is a lemongrower who dreams of gaining a prosperous future by showing complete loyalty to his boss, Baron Zito. However, Franco crosses a line, setting in motion the making of the world's first Mafia family. Malibu Rising by Taylor Jenkins Reid – Four famous siblings throw an epic party to celebrate the end of the summer. But over the course of twenty-four hours, their lives will change forever. Next in Line Warwick #5 by Jeffrey Archer – In 1988 London, royal fever sweeps the nation as Britain falls in love with the 'people's princess'. For Scotland Yard, the focus is on the elite Royalty Protection Command, and its commanding officer. Pineapple Street by Jenny Jackson – The three children of the old-money, well-connected Stockton family participate in the indulgent pleasures of life among New York's one-percenters. The Resemblance by Lauren Nossett – One chilly morning at the University of Georgia, a fraternity brother steps into the street and is struck dead by an oncoming car. All witnesses agree the driver looked identical to the victim, and he was smiling. <u>Signal Fires</u> by Dani Shapiro – On a summer night in 1985, three teenagers have been drinking. When one of them gets behind the wheel of a car, the circumstances of that fatal accident will become the deepest kind of secret. **Simply Lies** by David Baldacci – Two women—one a former detective, the other a dangerous con artist—clash in a game of cat and mouse. **Smolder** Anita Blake, Vampire Hunter #29 by Laurell K. Hamilton – Even though Anita is now engaged to the Vampire King of America, she must still do her job as a preternatural U.S. Marshall **Things We Do in the Dark** by Jennifer Hillier – Paris Peralta becomes an accused murderer when her old and very famous husband is found stabbed to death, and she also has a dark and dirty past. The Two Lives of Sara by Catherine Adel West – A young mother finds refuge and friendship at a

boardinghouse in 1960s Memphis, Tennessee.

Where are the Children Now? By Mary Higgins Clark – Over 40 years after Nancy was convicted of murdering her first two children, she's built a new life with two new children from a second marriage. The White Lady by Jaqueline Winspear – Elinor is a reluctant ex-spy who finds herself facing down one of the most dangerous crime gangs in London The Zero Night Johnathan Stride #11 by Brian Freeman – Johnathan and his wife Serena are investigating two cases: a kidnapping and a reexamination of a suicide from several years ago.
